### **FH Rosenheim (University of Applied Science)**

FH is the short term for Fachhochschule, the name used for German secondary schools. The Fachhochschule (University of Applied Science) located in Rosenheim works with King Mongkut's Institute of Technology in Northern Bangkok, KMIT NB University and the Office of Education Council Thailand OEC since 1999.

After the tsunami the university started fundraising in collaboration with the city of Rosenheim. Professors and students in the sector of timber construction and interior design made the decision to set up a relief project and build a kindergarten for about 60 orphans aged 3 – 5 years. Many enterprises and associations donated money so that the kindergarten could also furnish and decorate the interior. The project is officially led by the city of Rosenheim and overseen by Prof. Dr. Leidig (president of FH Rosenheim), Mr. Voradej (Vice Minister of the Prime Minister's office), Dr. Teravuti (president of KMITNB) and Dr. Chumpol (Vice Chairman of the KMITNB).
